

## The Church of St. George Christmas 2019 Wish List

The parish wish list is an alternative and creative way to present a gift to someone living (in tribute to) or deceased (in memory of) while supporting your parish in a significant way. All prices are approximations.

**New credence table, placed near altar in the chapel: \$1,300.00 (already donated by anonymous donor)**

**Baptismal font for the chapel (black marble from another parish) made available for cost of transportation by memorial gift from previous funds in honor of †Rose Madden**

**New statue of the Holy Family, mounted on a wooden oak backboard with bottom shelf, to be placed on brown brick wall, to the left of the outside window and to the right side of the tabernacle stand. Holy Family Statue, attached to the wooden oak board: \$ 6,135.00 (total for both parts) (Photo available if requested)**

**16 New Chairs with kneelers for the Chapel: \$500.00 (4 already donated in 2018)**

**The Baptism Of Christ, 1437-45 by Fra Angelico canvas art (framed canvas, XXL 40x60). Picture available upon request. (placed on the white cement brick wall behind the future site of new baptismal font in chapel): \$450.00**

Image representing the **Divine Will**, framed, for Chapel: price TBD, likely less than \$750.00.

**Ambry** mounted on a wall in Chapel (Wooden unit with glass front --- holds the containers of the three sacred oils, blessed by the Archbishop at the Chrism Mass) : \$965.00

**Ambry Set** (three crystal glass containers to contain the three sacred oils): \$275.00

**Bronze Missal Stand** for main altar in the church: \$930.00

**New Rite of Baptism for Children Book**, Bilingual version (effective in Feb. 2020): \$35.00

**AED-first aid station:** It is a portable life-saving device which shocks the heart to get the heart back to the normal rhythm. This monthly rental service, which also includes maintenance of the device, can be paid by one or more benefactors at the rate of \$115.00 *per month*. May be renewed annually on the Wish List, if sufficient interest remains. Photo is available in parish office.
