

A Reflection from the Pastor

In this informational article, I would like to provide you an update on our music director position and news about the chapel.

As we announced last weekend at Mass, our Music and Liturgy Director, Nuriel Abdenur, has taken a similar position at another Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. Nuriel's last day in the office was this past Tuesday, and she will be at Mass next Saturday, when she will be directing the choir for the final time. We wish her well in her new endeavors. Please stop by the Community Center after the 9:15 am Sunday Mass to attend a reception that is taking place in her honor.

Our former music director, Kelly Kadlec, has agreed to be our interim music director until December 31st. Her duties will be limited to roles of an accompanist, cantor, and director of the adult and teen choirs. Also, she will not have any office hours. The Cherub Choir is on hold until we have hired a new music director.

In the meantime, we have begun our search for a new music director. A job description has been posted on the Archdiocesan website and at other locations. Our plan and hope are to hire a new staff music individual within the next two months and have them work alongside Kelly for a period. Our music program is too important to hire someone without having a smooth, overlapping transition.

You might have noticed that we are presently hiring only for the position of a music director. In my love for the liturgy, I will now take on the liturgical ministry with the assistance of Sara Dore. Most likely, you will not observe much difference, except for the scheduling of liturgical ministers for Mass; Sara will once again be doing the scheduling and the writing the Prayers of the Faithful for Mass. On a positive side note, this change will save us a little financially.

Now turning to the other purpose of this article, that is, to update you on the chapel. I have great news the new chapel chairs have arrived and will be put in the chapel this week. I hope that after years and years of wanting to get new, more comfortable chairs, that you will be pleased. We have sixteen chairs, of which ten have kneelers attached. Since there still is not any kneelers for the front row of chairs, individuals can use a kneeling pad, that will be placed under six of the eight front chairs. If you are sitting in a front row chair during Mass or at other times, there are two second row chairs that have kneelers attached, which can be used.

With the new carpet and chairs, and after discussions with several parishioners, we now have a few new requests that we ask you respect, with the hope that the chapel will be and look less cluttered. Soon, a new larger cabinet that is being built by Tom Barret, will replace the bookshelf under the board to the left when coming into the chapel. Items can be placed in the cabinet. Therefore, we request that no rosaries be left on the chairs, and no items left on any of the window ledges, front of the ambo, or below the Holy Family statue. One more thing, if you move a chair, please return it exactly to its previous place.

Please pray for a new music director and keep the chapel clean and uncluttered.

ELECTRONIC GIVING VIA EGIVING

Have you been meaning to set up electronic giving? Now you can do that for yourself on a phone or another device. Go to the giving page on our website: https://stgeorgelonglake.org/ donate/

If you have not already created an account, click on *Sign in* and scroll down and click on the blue text which says *Create one*. You will be prompted to add your contact information (you will need either a cellphone number or email address) and donation source information (bank account, credit card, etc.)

Then you will return to the main giving page and click on the *Give Now* button where you can choose to click on "recurring" payment or "one-time" payment. Then you will choose which fund you would like your donation directed to (e.g. Sunday Offertory, Building and Maintenance, etc). If you set up a one time payment, you will enter your amount, then scroll to the bottom and hit submit. If you'd like to set up a recurring payment, you will need to select the "Fund", then enter the amount, then the "frequency" and the start date before scrolling to the bottom and hitting submit. If you are still set up to give electronically through Vanco, you need to transition over to eGiving by setting up a new recurring donation through eGiving and to contact Paula or Sara to request to stop your Vanco donation. If you need help, either Paula or Sara can help walk you through getting set up on your phone.
