First Communion and Confirmation

Call or email the church where your son/daughter was baptized to request a Certificate of Baptism. We are not looking for an original certificate but rather a recently issued certificate which would include any notations on the back. <u>Safe Environment Policy and Requirements from the Archdiocese of St. Paul & Minneapolis:</u>
The following requirements <u>must be completed prior to</u> volunteer duties with minors.

Volunteers ages 18 years and older who have contact with children and youth are required to complete the Essential 3 (E3) requirements: Background Check, Code of Conduct, and Safe Environment Training that includes: VIRTUS training and Reporting Suspected Child Abuse training. These requirements and registration for VIRTUS training are done online at www.virtus.org. Volunteers younger than 18 years old will sign a Youth Code of Conduct and submit two reference letters written by trustworthy adults attesting to their character, lack of misconduct, and dependability for the volunteer position.
