**What Is BIM?**

BIM stands for Building Improvements and Maintenance. The money you donate in the blue envelopes helps us keep up with needed repairs and maintenance. Recently we had our annual roof inspection which required \$1,900 in emergency repairs. These annual inspections and resulting repairs have lengthened the life of our roof by catching and fixing developing problems before damage became more extensive and costly. Last month our sewer backed up, requiring hydrojetting of the line all the way to where our line meets the city sewage line. This service cost \$2,160. We also had to replace a faulty kitchen exhaust fan this month for \$1,280. Thank you for helping us to keep our church facilities in safe and working condition!
